2. Nomination Committee

The Nomination Committee has been appointed by National President Senator Ronald KAN in order to assess the qualification and eligibility of the candidates and will present a report during the Closing General Assembly of 53rd National Convention. Apart from me serving as the Chairman, the Nomination Committee includes four other members:

1999 National President Senator Louise CHAN
 2010 National President Senator Gene TANG
 2013 National President Senator Paul WU
 2015 National President Senator Anthony LEUNG

3. Eligibility and Qualifications of Candidates

The procedures for the election of 2018 Elective National Officers are conducted in accordance with the Memorandum and Articles of Association and By-laws of Junior Chamber International Hong Kong. All candidates are required to observe and comply with these clauses therein.

The qualifications for candidates of the Elective National Offices are contained in JCIHK By-law 12-4. Specific requirements for NP, NEVPs, NVPs, NGLC, NSG, NHT and NDs are contained in By-laws 12-9-3, 12-11-2, 12-12-2, 12-10-2, 12-13-2, 12-14-2 and 12-15-2 respectively.

The Nomination Committee confirms that all the candidates fulfil the qualifications as specified in By-law 12-4 and are eligible and qualified for the offices they are standing for election and appointment with the following exceptions:

- (a) National Vice President Candidates CHOR, Wing Tung Claudia (JCI Kowloon), LAM, Tony (JCI Harbour), NGAN, Tsz Ho (JCI Dragon), TSE, Chun Hei (JCI North District), NGAN, Ting Ting Kelly (JCI Sha Tin), WONG, Wing Sze Queenice (JCI Victoria) fail to meet Specific Requirement under By-law 12-12-2 (C), i.e. the candidate shall be a current Member of the National Board of Directors or shall have been a Member of the National Board of Directors for at least one year;

Notwithstanding their failure to meet the specific requirements or qualifications, the six candidates may seek for election or appointment by way of a waiver in accordance with By-law 12-4-9. The Nomination Committee recommends such waiver be granted subject to the approval of the General Assembly by a 2/3 majority.

4. Candidate Training School

In accordance with By-law 12-4-5, all elective candidates attended the Candidates Training School with the following details:

5. Interview by the Nomination Committee

Interview for all Candidates for Elective Members, as per Constitutional requirement (By-law 12-4-7), have been conducted on 13th September 2018 at the Chamber Office by the Nomination Committee to assess the ability of each candidate in the following areas:

- Junior Chamber Affairs at Local, National & International levels
- Parliamentary Procedure
- Memorandum and Articles of Association and By-laws of Junior Chamber International Hong Kong
- Duties of the respective offices and Problem Solving
- Community Affairs

The performance of individual Candidates was graded in accordance with the following scale:

1. Excellent
2. Very Good
3. Good
4. Fair
5. Poor
6. Unsatisfactory

Interview results of each candidate in respective area are shown in appendix 1 which also posted on JCI Hong Kong website on or before 18th September 2018.

The results are based on the performance of the candidates in the interview session. According to the observation of the Committee, the candidates were generally nervous, which might affect their performance and look less confident. However, we agree that they are well-prepared and generally have in-depth understanding on articles of association and by-law as well as their roles and responsibilities and community affairs, but further parliamentary procedure training is needed in order to enhance the meeting efficiency. For JCI Knowledge, most candidates might need to enhance their knowledge about different current JCI partners and programs. The candidates are advised to study more current affairs in order to equip themselves as leaders on behalf of JCIHK in the coming year. As the key leaders in JCIHK, the candidates should have a thorough understanding on the global JC movement so that they can differentiate JC with other youth organizations in terms of the international affairs exposure to our members.

6. Closure of Nomination

In accordance with By-law 12-6-3, all nominations had been closed 45 days prior to the commencement of the National Convention.



7. Conclusion
