2. Nomination Committee

The Nomination Committee has been appointed by National President Senator Winnie Yeung to assess the qualification and eligibility of the candidates and present a report to the General Assembly of 56th National Convention. Apart from me serving as the Chairman, the Nomination Committee includes four other members:

- 1996 National President Senator Justin LUI
- 2015 National President Senator Anthony LEUNG
- 2017 National President Senator Teresa POON
- 2018 National President Senator Ronald KAN

3. Eligibility and Qualifications of Candidates

The procedures for the election of 2022 Elective National Officers are conducted in accordance with the Memorandum and Articles of Association and By-laws of Junior Chamber International Hong Kong. All candidates are required to observe and comply with these clauses therein.

The qualifications for candidates of the Elective National Offices are contained in JCIHK Bylaw 12-4. Specific requirements for NP, NEVPs, NVPs, NGLC, NSG, NHT and NDs are contained in By-laws 12-9-3, 12-11-2, 12-12-2, 12-10-2, 12-13-2, 12-14-2 and 12-15-2 respectively.

The Nomination Committee confirms that all the candidates fulfil the qualifications as specified in By-law 12-4 and are eligible and qualified for the offices they are standing

for election and appointment with the following exceptions:

National Vice President Candidates CHAN, Chun Wai Goffy (JCI Tai Ping Shan), CHENG, Yu Wo (JCI Sha Tin), JIANG, Yihong (JCI Queensway), LAM, Tuk Tsuen (JCI Victoria), LEE, Shu Kai (JCI Dragon), NG, Pui Ying (JCI Apex), WONG, Ho Yan Rosanna (JCI Hong Kong Jayceettes), YIP, Chi Yeung (JCI Island) fail to meet Specific Requirement under By-law 12-12-2 (C), i.e. the candidate shall be a current Member of the National Board of Directors or shall have been a Member of the National Board of Directors for at least one year.

Notwithstanding their failure to meet the specific requirements or qualifications, the eight candidates may seek for election or appointment by way of a waiver in accordance with Bylaw 12-4-9. The Nomination Committee recommends such waiver be granted subject to the approval of the General Assembly by a 2/3 majority.

4. Candidates Training School

In accordance with By-law 12-4-5, all elective candidates attended the Candidates Training School with the following details:

Topic 1: How to advance the JCI Value for your personal growth

Guest Speaker: 2009 National President Senator Ken Wong

Topic 2: How to effectively engage partners for International events and enhancement of the branding of JCI Hong Kong

Guest Speaker: Mr. Caspar Tsui Ying-wai, JP, Secretary for Home Affairs

5. Interview by the Nomination Committee

Interview for all candidates for Elective National Officers, as per Constitutional requirement (By-law 12-4-7), has been conducted on 17th & 18th September 2021 at the Chamber Office by the Nomination Committee to assess the ability of each candidate in the following areas:

- i. Junior Chamber Affairs at Local, National & International levels
- ii. Parliamentary Procedure
- iii. Memorandum and Articles of Association and By-laws of Junior Chamber International Hong Kong
- iv. Duties of the respective offices and Problem Solving
- v. Community Affairs

The performance of individual candidates was graded in accordance with the following scale:

1. Excellent
2. Very Good
3. Good
4. Fair
5. Poor
6. Unsatisfactory

Interview results of each candidate in respective area are shown in Appendix 1 which was also posted on JCI Hong Kong website on or before 26th September 2021.

The results are based on the performance of the candidates in the interview session.

According to the observation of the Committee, the candidates were overall confident and passionate. We agree that they are well-prepared and generally have in-depth understanding on articles of association and by-laws as well as their roles and responsibilities and JCI affairs, but they should be more aware of community affairs in order to perform as an informed leader and enhance their knowledge on parliamentary procedures as a role-model for Chapters. The world is ever-changing with new challenges, especially under COVID-19 pandemic. The candidates should be all rounded and demonstrate good problem-solving skills so as to act as a living example of a competent and capable leader of our beloved organisation.

6. Closure of Nomination

In accordance with By-law 12-6-3, all nominations had been closed 45 days prior to the commencement of the National Convention.

7. Conclusion

Taking this opportunity, I would like to extend my heartfelt thanks to nomination committee members, 1996 National President Senator Justin LUI, 2015 National President Senator Anthony LEUNG, 2017 National President Senator Teresa POON, 2018 National President Senator Ronald KAN, for their time, effort and contribution in this election, National Secretariat and Administrative Team, and Chamber Executive Phyllis Chan.
