2. Nomination Committee

The Nomination Committee has been appointed by National President Senator Karen Yeung to assess the qualification and eligibility of the candidates and present a report to the General Assembly of the 57th National Convention. Apart from me serving as the Chairman, the Nomination Committee includes five other members:

1992 National President Senator Eddy WONG
 2006 National President Senator James TSUI
 2010 National President Senator Gene TANG
 2015 National President Senator Anthony LEUNG
 2019 National President Senator Zenith LIN

3. Eligibility and Qualifications of Candidates

The election procedure for the election of 2023 Elective National Officers is conducted in accordance with the Memorandum and Articles of Association and By-laws of Junior Chamber International Hong Kong. All candidates are required to observe and comply with these clauses therein.

The qualifications for candidates of the Elective National Offices are contained in JCIHK Bylaw 12-4. Specific requirements for NP, NEVPs, NVPs, NGLC, NSG, NHT and NDs are contained in By-laws 12-9-3, 12-11-2, 12-12-2, 12-10-2, 12-13-2, 12-14-2 and 12-15-2 respectively.

The Nomination Committee confirms that all the candidates fulfil the qualifications as specified in By-law 12-4 and are eligible and qualified for the offices they are standing for election and appointment with the following exceptions:

National General Legal Counsel Candidate: CHEUNG, TSZ KWAN (JCI North District); Requirement under By-law 12-10-2 (C), i.e. the candidate shall be a current Elective Member of the National Board of Directors or shall have been an Elective Member of the National Board of Directors for at least one year.

National Vice President Candidates: CHAN, CHUNG YIN DOROTHY (JCI Harbour), CHAN, MANG SING MANSON (JCI Victoria), CHAN, VIRGINIA (JCI Lion Rock), CHEUNG, WAI (JCI Dragon), LAM, CHUNG YIN (JCI Island), YIM, HEI WA (JCI City Lady), YUN, SIN YEE NATALIE (JCI Bauhinia); and National Honorary Treasurer Candidate: LEUNG, SING PIU (JCI Kowloon), fail to meet Specific Requirement under By-law 12-12-2 (C), i.e. the candidate shall be a current Member of the National Board of Directors or shall have been a Member of the National Board of Directors for at least one year.

Notwithstanding their failure to meet the specific requirements or qualifications, the nine candidates may seek for election or appointment by way of a waiver in accordance with By-law 12-4-9. The Nomination Committee recommends such waiver be granted subject to the approval of the General Assembly by a 2/3 majority.

4. Candidates Training School

In accordance with By-law 12-4-5, all elective candidates attended the Candidates Training School with the following details:

Topic 1: How JCIHK can enhance international relationship and cooperation with Mainland to create bigger impact.

Topic 2: Insight and Sharing on the recent development of Mainland China

5. Interview by the Nomination Committee

Interview for all candidates for Elective National Officers, as per Constitutional requirement (By-law 12-4-7), has been conducted on 17th September 2022 at the Chamber Office by the Nomination Committee to assess the ability of each candidate in the following areas:

**Junior Chamber affairs at Local, National & International levels*

**Parliamentary procedure*

**Articles of Association and By-laws of Junior Chamber International Hong Kong*

**Duties of the respective offices and problem-solving skills*

**Community affairs*

The performance of individual candidates was graded in accordance with the following scale:

1. Excellent
2. Very Good
3. Good
4. Fair
5. Needs Improvement

Interview results of each candidate in respective area are shown in Appendix 1 which was also posted on JCI Hong Kong website on or before 25th September 2022.

The results are based on the performance of the candidates in the interview session.

According to the observation of the Committee, the candidates were overall confident and passionate. We agree that they are well-prepared and generally have in-depth understanding on articles of association and by-laws as well as their roles and responsibilities and JCI affairs, but they should be more aware of community affairs in order to perform as an informed leader and enhance their knowledge on parliamentary procedures as a role-model for Chapters. The world is ever-changing with new challenges, especially under COVID-19 pandemic. The candidates should be all rounded and demonstrate good problem-solving skills so as to act as a living example of a competent and capable leader of our beloved organisation.

6. Closure of Nomination

In accordance with By-law 12-6-3, all nominations had been closed 45 days prior to the commencement of the National Convention.
