



## JCIHK 2023 Membership Affairs Area Active Member Framework

In order to orient new members, as well as to encourage new members to be active, Junior Chamber International Hong Kong (JCIHK) Membership Affairs Area presents a recognition program for fresh members – “Active Member Framework 2023”.

Members are encouraged to achieve particular level of the Framework by participating respective activities or being certain position. There are 5 levels of recognition for the Framework:

**Level 5** – Enthusiast

**Level 4** – Explorer

**Level 3** – Discoverer

**Level 2** – Beginner

**Level 1** – Newbie

### **Eligibility**

Only eligible for paid up JCIHK members who joined JCIHK in 2021 or onwards to apply i.e.: Joined as Prospective Member (PM) on or after 1 January 2021

### **Application Period**

Season	Submission Period	Awards Presentation
1	19 July 2023 – 25 Aug 2023	National Convention (23 September 2023)
2	1 November 2023 - 30 November 2023	Joint Director Meeting 2 (9 December 2023)

### **Submission of Application**

Records shall be submitted as proofs of participation of events, such as photo, payment record or certificate.

Application link will be provided during application period, please keep the record for submission.

### **Scope**

The position or events event joined must be within 1 January - 31 December 2023; unless specified cases, such as Graduates of 5-Star Training / PA / EA Camp and JCI Official Course.

Physical and Virtual events are both acceptable.



## Active Member Framework – Awards Scheme

**ALL** items in each level are required to achieve to be qualified for respective level.

**ALL** lower levels are required to achieve before reaching the higher ones.

### Level 5 – Enthusiast

- Attendance of 10 events hosted by different LOMs (other than AGM / IC / Anniversary); AND
- 5 x Attendance of NOM Workshop / JCI Official Course / Town Hall Meeting; AND
- 1 x Attendance / Paid Registration of Area Conference / World Congress; AND
- 1 x Being SO / Chairman / OC / Helper of NOM event; AND
- 1 x Graduated (from 2021 to 2023) / Attendance (in 2023) of 5-Star Training / PA / EA Camp

### Level 4 – Explorer

- 5 x Attendance / Paid Registration of LOM IC / AGM / Anniversary (including Mother Chapter); AND
- 5 x Attendance of LOM MFG; AND
- 5 x Being SO / Chairman / OC / Helper of event (NOM / LOM); AND
- 2 x Graduated in JCI Official Course (from 2021 to 2023); AND
- 1 x IA Reception / Visit of Sister Chapter / NOM

### Level 3 – Discoverer

- 5 x Attendance of Mother Chapter events (other than AGM / IC / Anniversary); AND
- 5 x Attendance of any LOM event (other than Mother Chapter); AND
- 2 x Attendance of NOM workshop / JCI Official Course / Town Hall Meeting; AND
- 1 x Attendance / Paid Registration of NOM IC / NC; AND
- 1 x Being Project Chairman / LOM BOD

### Level 2 – Beginner

- 2 x Attendance of LOM MFG / Flagship event (other than Mother Chapter); AND
- 2 x Attendance / Paid Registration of LOM IC / AGM (including Mother Chapter); AND
- 1 x Attendance of NOM event

### Level 1 – Newbie

- 3 x Attendance of Mother Chapter events; AND
- 2 x Being SO / Chairman / OC / Helper of Mother Chapter Events



## Glossary

NOM	: National Organization Member, herein means JCI Hong Kong
LOM	: Local Organization Member, herein means Affiliated Chapters of JCI Hong Kong
IC	: Inaugural Ceremony
NC	: National Convention
AGM	: Annual General Meeting
PA Camp	: President Academy
EA Camp	: Executive Academy
IA	: International Affairs
MFG	: Monthly Fellowship Gathering
OC	: Organizing Committee
SO	: Supervising Officer

## Definition / Interpretation

- **“Events”** are formal or official JCI events, which do not include OC Meeting or casual gathering.
- **“Attendance”** includes attending the event in role of Speaker / Trainer / Facilitator / SO / OC / Helpers / Participants / Audience.
- **“Hello JC”** is treated as equivalent to “5-Star Training Camp”, which the name “Hello JC” was used in 2020-2022.
- **“NOM Workshop”** includes, but not limited to Admin Workshop, Membership Workshop, Business Affair Workshop, E-Bidbook Seminar, Trainer Mentorship Programme (TMP) Workshop, Empowerment Day etc. Workshop Sessions in Empowerment Day can be counted separately
- **“Hello JC”, “EA Camp”, “PA Camp”** and **“Public Speaking Championship (Workshop / Contest)”** are **“NOM event”** co-hosted by LOM.
- **“NOM event”** include, but not limited to the above-mentioned **“NOM Workshop”, “NOM event co-hosted by LOM”, “Debate Championship”, “Town Hall Meeting”, “National Business Networking (NBN) events”** etc.



### Terms & Conditions

Application must be submitted before the submission deadlines. JCIHK will not accept late submission by the Local Chapter. For late submission of Season 1, calculation for certain awards will be deferred to Season 2.

JCIHK Membership Team reserves the right to make any changes of the Active Member Framework and terms and conditions of which at any time without further notice. In case of any dispute, JCIHK Membership Team has the final decision of qualifications of the Framework Awards Scheme.
