Champion of Champions Guidelines

(Managed by National Corporate Communications Team)

Objectives

- To promote greater participation of JCIHK's members in various inter-chapter events.
- To encourage JCIHK's local chapters to create more positive competition events for members.

Marking Scheme

1. Event hosted by **one chapter**: 10 Points will be given to the chapter.
2. Event co-hosted by **two or more chapters**: 10 Points will be divided by the number of chapters (round to the nearest whole number).

Marking Scheme

3. The Champion of each Category will be given the Points as follows:

Ranking	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10
Points	10	9	8	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

4. All participants will be given 1 Point for their participation.

5. In order to encourage the number of participants and to promote the fairness between different sizes of chapters, a chapter which has over 10% of the total number of ordinary member# to join will be given extra 10 Points. Over 20% will have extra 15 Points, so on and so forth. No upper limit of the extra Points will be given.

The total number of ordinary member will be counted as the number declared in the latest Joint-Board Meeting before the COC Program.

Marking Scheme

7. The score of chapters in each individual COC program will be counted and accumulated until the completion of the last COC series.
8. The top three chapters with the highest total score in the year will win the Champion, 1st Running-up and 2nd Running-up of the year.
9. Hosting chapter(s) should submit the results to NCC Team within 1 month after the COC completion.

Privileges for Hosting Chapter(s)

10. Hosting chapter(s) would enjoy the privileges as follows (subject to the content provided by hosting chapter(s)):

- 1 exclusive promotion email/EDM
- 1 pre-event post in NOM social media platform
- 1 event recap post in NOM social media platform
- 12 marks of Bonus EI*

* To be shared among the hosting chapter(s), round to the nearest whole number; and subject to the completion of Item no. 9 above of this COC Guidelines.

Application Procedure
